

Lone traveller policy

At the Best Western Weymouth Hotel Rembrandt we understand that every guest has different needs. Travelling alone, often far from home, can bring its own worries, so the hotel operates a lone female guest awareness policy to make sure women travelling on their own feel safe when they stay with us.

WHAT WE DO

Safety measures we implement and adhere to

- When allocating a room to a woman travelling alone, we do not use rooms at the end of corridors or next to fire exits.
- We offer an escort from the hotel to the car park, especially at night.
- Our on site parking is well lit, with CCTV where circumstances permit.
- We never read out a female guest's room number at check in.
- We make lone female guests aware that every room has a secondary locking device on the door for added security.
- We never give out a lone female guest's name or room number.
- Bedside lighting controls are standard in every room.
- Same sex room service is provided on request.

We endeavour to apply this policy on every occasion. It is subject to availability at the time of booking, force majeure, and the guest's own wish for the policy to be applied.

If you would like any of these measures during your stay, please mention it when you book or speak to reception on arrival. Reception is staffed 24 hours a day: dial 0 from your room.
